



Board Connection Expectations:

What can the Board Connection participant expect now that he/she has taken the class?

Steps to a Board Connection by the participant -

- Board Connection participant completes registration online to attend an upcoming Board Connection Course (BCC).
- Prior to the BCC, the participant will complete his/her online volunteer profile.
- During the BCC the participant will learn characteristics of nonprofit boards as well as how to search for board opportunities.
- At the completion of the BCC, “interested” participants will give OneOC permission to share their online profile with our nonprofit members and will be given a certificate of completion and registration code to proceed with their online search for Board Opportunities (BO).
- After attending the BCC “interested” participants are encouraged to express interest with up to three nonprofit BO postings, where an auto-email will be sent directly to the nonprofit organization.
- Once the connection is made and the participant is contacted by the nonprofit organization, the participant commits to responding with the nonprofit, within 48 hours to set up a meeting to speak/meet at the convenience of both parties.

Steps to a Board Connection by OneOC –

- OneOC will offer a high-quality BCC to registered individuals throughout the year.
- OneOC will offer free HandsOn Connect webinar to our nonprofit members throughout the year.
- OneOC will only allow BO connections for individuals that have completed the BCC and their online volunteer profile.
- OneOC will only allow BO postings from current nonprofit accelerated or premium members that have completed and signed the Board Connection Program Memorandum of Understanding.
- OneOC will communicate with each participant regarding registration, how to complete their online volunteer profile, searching for BO opportunities and “expressing interest” with the resignation code.
- OneOC will follow-up directly with participants that completed the BCC after 30 days.

Steps to a Board Connection by the nonprofit organization (OneOC Accelerated and Premium Members) –

- OneOC current Accelerated and Premium members must sign a Board Connection Program Memorandum of Understanding with OneOC committing to their interest in participating in the Board Connection Program.
- Nonprofit organization commits to attending and posting their own Board Opportunities (volunteer postings) on www.OneOC.org by participating in a free, one-hour webinar hosted by OneOC.
- Nonprofit posts their board volunteer positions on www.OneOC.org
- Nonprofit organization commits to respond within 48 business hours of initial email contact to the interested participant and set up a meeting to speak/meet at the convenience of both parties.
- Nonprofit organization commits to communicating with OneOC regarding the status of the candidate and if the nonprofit organization will proceed with a connection
